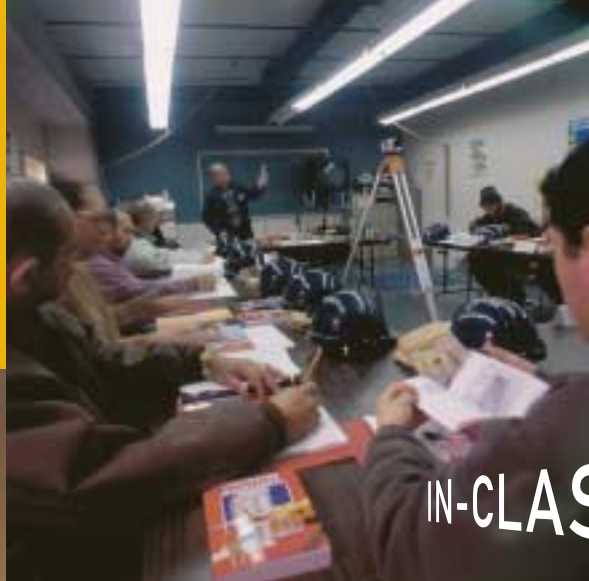

trained to maintain a safe worksite and to handle any situation.

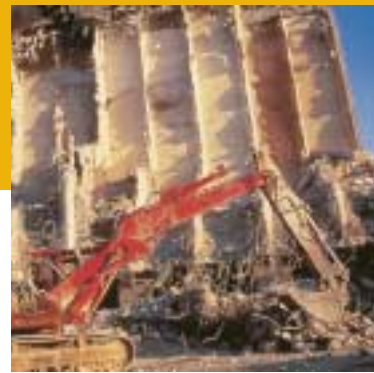

The Ontario Construction Secretariat (OCS) was established as a joint Labour, Management and Government initiative through the 1992 revisions to the Labour Relations Act. The OCS's mandate is to collect and distribute statistics and general information on the organized Industrial, Commercial and Institutional (ICI) construction industry. Building a consensus on the accuracy of this information creates a shared vision of strengths and challenges. In addition, the OCS promotes the interests of the industry, seeking opportunities to create jobs and strengthen all stakeholders. The OCS brings union members, contractors, owner/clients and key government decision-makers together outside the crisis of collective bargaining to focus on issues of common concern.

The OCS is funded by workers and contractors and governed by a Board of Directors drawn from Ontario's government and twenty five Employer and Employee Bargaining Agencies (EBAs). Goals and related activities are set out in a five-year plan and managed by three working committees: data/Statistics, Industry Promotion and Education/Outreach.
