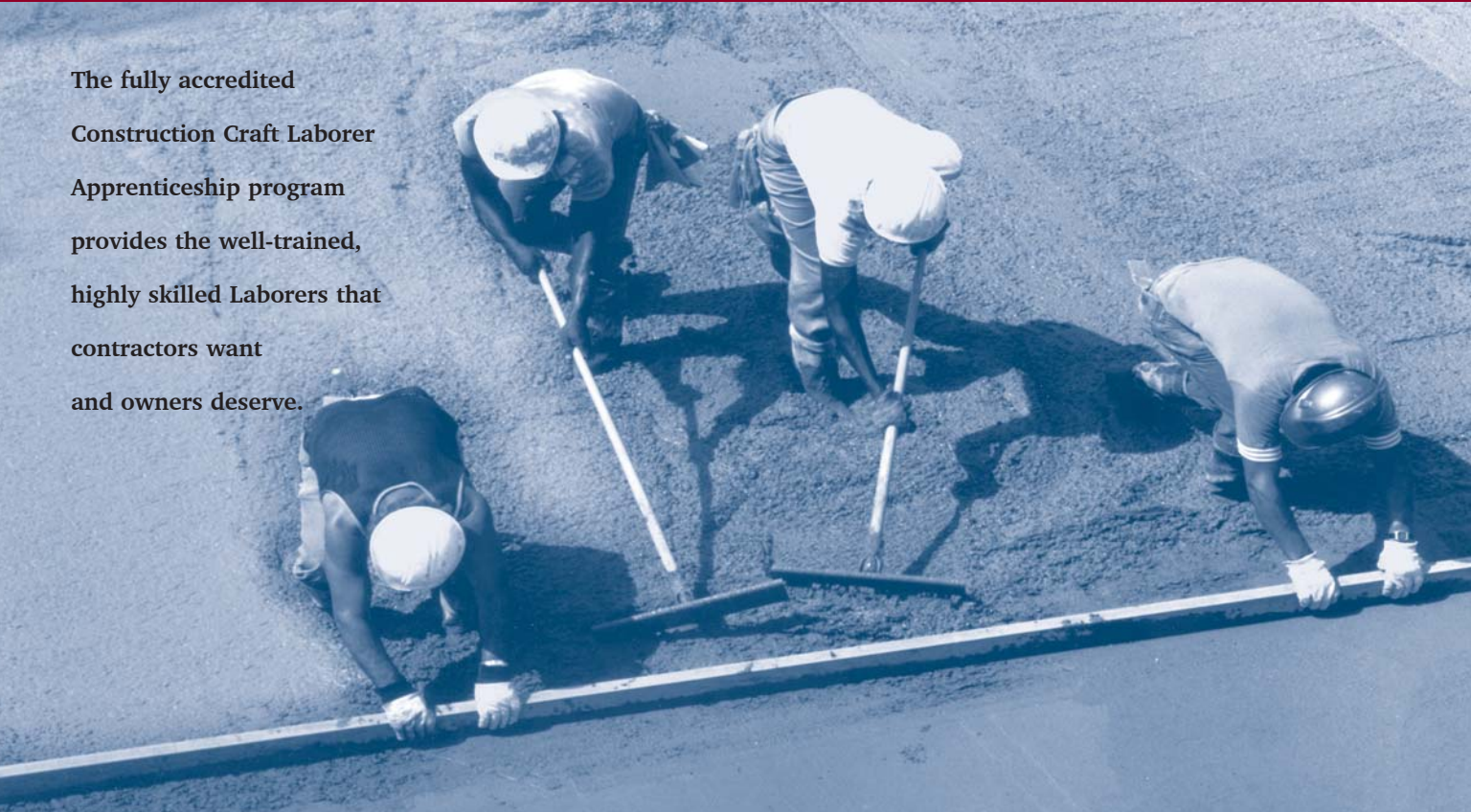


# LOOKING FOR PEOPLE, NOT PROPAGANDA? CALL THE LABORERS

- ◆ 4,000 hours of on-the-job training;
- ◆ Training and work experience in building construction, heavy/highway construction, and environmental remediation;
- ◆ Classes in general construction, specialty, and core Laborer skills;
- ◆ Drug and alcohol screening.

And at LIUNA, apprenticeship is only the beginning. Throughout their careers, Laborers can upgrade their skills and hone their trade at any one of 70 training sites throughout North America. More than 50 specialty skills courses enable Laborers to augment their basic skills. And mobile training facilities can bring specific training programs to the job site or the union hall.
