### OTHER ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Worked with other unions, community organizations, and Native Hawaiian groups to support development of geothermal energy facilities which would lead to projects and jobs for Laborers and their signatory contractors.
- Provided project tracking and research to Laborers' Local Union 368 and its signatory contractors.
- Worked to ensure that LIUNA signatory contractors can compete on a level playing field by monitoring public construction projects for compliance with state and federal prevailing wage and labor laws.
- Co-sponsored the Hawaii Construction Industry Awareness Program, which promotes construction careers to high-school students throughout the state.

### Hawaii LECET Goes to Bat for Projects, Jobs

Throughout 2010, Hawaii LECET met with state and local officials to support several major projects in the state, and to help project owners obtain permits and approvals. The fund also worked to generate public support for a wide range of public and private construction projects on the Hawaiian Islands.

Among the projects Hawaii LECET worked to support were:

- The \$5-billion Honolulu Mass Transit Project
- The \$1.2-billion Thirty Meter Telescope on Mauna Kea on the Big Island
- The \$700-million redevelopment of the Princess Kaiulani and Moana Surfrider hotels
- The Koa Ridge and Ho'opili developments on Oahu

Hawaii LECET also helped convince state legislators to approve more than \$75 million worth of funding for construction on the University of Hawaii's West Oahu and Hilo campuses.
