

OTHER ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Worked with Laborers' Local Union 1140 to help Trans Canada Corporation with its ongoing efforts to obtain permits for the \$4-billion Keystone XL Pipeline.
- Worked with the Heartland Region of the General Services Administration to help Laborers and their signatory contractors win work on the \$1-billion Bannister Hazardous Waste Cleanup project in Kansas City, Missouri.
- Continued to utilize pension investment information from the LIUNA Department of Corporate Affairs to build relationships with owners, developers, and contractors.
- Helped Laborers' Local Unions 264 and 1140 develop weatherization training and pursue residential weatherization work, as part of LIUNA's Home Performance Campaign.

Midwest Region LECET Pursues Wind Power Projects, Jobs

Midwest Region LECET helped Laborers and their signatory contractors monitor and pursue projects and jobs associated with the approximately 200 wind farms currently in development across the Region. To pursue work that is valued at more than \$45 billion, the fund has:

- Helped wind farm owners and developers clear regulatory and permitting hurdles.
- Connected a large wind farm developer with potential sources of financing.
- Promoted Laborers, their signatory contractors, and LIUNA's national wind energy agreements at Wind Power 2010, the wind energy industry's largest annual trade show.

Midwest LECET also has pursued the energy infrastructure projects associated with wind farms, identifying more than 35 transmission line projects in some stage of development throughout the Region. The fund has alerted signatory contractors involved in this type of work about upcoming project opportunities, and has been building relationships with utilities and other owners to help Laborers and contractors win this work.
